

The requirements below are for OUTDOOR events only.

This document is subject to change based on continued guidance from the Department of Health.

Baseball & Softball:

Mask expectations:

- 1. All athletes, coaches, umpires, event staff and spectators are required to wear a face mask at all times while on campus at Bishop McDevitt.
- 2. All athletes, coaches and game personnel in the dugout or on team bench must wear a face mask at all times.
- 3. Face mask exceptions:
 - a. When a team is on the field, outfielders do not need to wear a face covering.
 - b. When a team is on the field, infielders do not need to wear a face covering, unless there is a baserunner near their position, then a mask is required.
 - c. A pitcher does not need to wear a face covering while pitching.
 - d. Any player without a face covering while playing on the field must put a face covering on prior to entering the dugout or gathering on the field with teammates.
- 4. While on the bases, athletes must wear a face covering.
- 5. Both umpires must wear a face covering at all times.

Spectator Guidelines:

All HOME and AWAY player parents/immediate family members are allowed to attend our baseball/softball events. Spectators may also include families of the coaching staff, Bishop McDevitt faculty, school board and special dignitaries. All spectators must wear a mask and are asked to respectfully sit in family pods together and bring your own chairs. If choosing to sit in our provided bleachers, people must be socially distanced as best as you can in with the bleacher space provided. There will be no concession stand available and no admission charge. If you have any questions please contact the athletic department. Boys Tennis:

Mask expectations:

- 1. All athletes, coaches, umpires, event staff and spectators are required to wear a face mask at all times while on campus at Bishop McDevitt.
- 2. All athletes and coaches must wear a face mask when outside of the tennis courts.

3. Face mask exceptions:

- a. Singles players may remove their face mask while playing and warming up on the court.
- b. Doubles players may remove their face mask while playing and warming up on the
- c. Any player without a face mask while playing on the court must put a face mask on prior to switching sides with the opponent, leaving the court at the end of a match/game, and/or exiting the tennis courts area.
- d. Remaining a minimum of 6' socially, distanced while on the court without a mask must be strictly enforced.

Spectator Guidelines:

All HOME and AWAY player parents/immediate family members are allowed to attend our tennis matches. Spectators may also include families of the coaching staff, Bishop McDevitt faculty, school board and special dignitaries. All spectators must wear a mask and are asked to respectfully sit in family pods together and bring your own chairs. If choosing to sit in our provided bleachers, people must be socially distanced as best as you can in with the bleacher space provided. There will be no concession stand available and no admission charge. If you have any questions please contact the athletic department. Track & Field:

Mask expectations:

- 1. All athletes, coaches, umpires, event staff and spectators are required to wear a face mask at all times while on campus at Bishop McDevitt.
- 2. All athletes, coaches and officials must wear a face mask when moving around campus to different events and any time not competing in an event. Athletes and spectators are not permitted to gather around the start/finish line or around the track. All individuals attending the track meet must keep a distance from those athletes participating.
- 3. Face mask exceptions:

All running events:

- a. Runners must wear a face mask until they get into position for their event at which time, they can lower their face mask. When finished running, runners should distance themselves from everyone while catching their breath and then put their face mask back over their mouth and nose in a reasonable amount of time after they have recovered and before coming in contact with others.
- b. When possible, a lane (s) will be skipped between opponents on the track to help promote social distancing.

All throwing and jumping events:

a. For throwing and jumping events, when an individual enters the area they are competing for their event, they can remove or lower their face mask temporarily. For example, if someone is throwing the discus, his/her mask can be removed once he/she enters the circle to make a throw. The face mask must be put back on prior to leaving the circle.

Any athlete competing without a face mask (whether on the track or throwing area) must put a face mask on prior to leaving their area of competition.

Spectator Guidelines:

All HOME and AWAY player parents/immediate family members are allowed to attend our track meets. Spectators may also include families of the coaching staff, Bishop McDevitt faculty, school board and special dignitaries. All spectators must wear a mask and are asked to respectfully sit in family pods together and/or bring your own chairs for the field events. If choosing to sit in our provided bleachers, people must be socially distanced as best as you can in with the bleacher space provided. There will be no concession stand available and no admission charge. If you have any questions please contact the athletic department. Girls & Boys Lacrosse:

Mask expectations:

- 1. All athletes, coaches, umpires, event staff and spectators are required to wear a face mask at all times while on campus at Bishop McDevitt.
- 2. All athletes, coaches and game personnel on the sidelines must wear a face mask at all times.
- 3. Face Mask exceptions: When a team is on the field, the players do not have to wear a face mask. Any player not wearing a face mask should while playing on the field must put a face mask on when returning to the sidelines.
- 4. All athletes and coaches should have a face mask when leaving the facility.

Spectator Guidelines:

All HOME and AWAY player parents/immediate family members are allowed to attend our lacrosse games. Spectators may also include families of the coaching staff, Bishop McDevitt faculty, school board and special dignitaries. All spectators must wear a mask and are asked to respectfully sit in family pods together. There will be no concession stand available and there is a \$5 admission charge.
